

EXECUTIVE ORDER

Subject: Highway Safety		Number: 1987-10 Amended

WHEREAS, there is a need to review highway safety problems of the Commonwealth and to present advice necessary to improve safety on our highways and reduce the frequency and severity of highway accidents; and

WHEREAS, the death, injury, and property damage losses associated with highway accidents in Pennsylvania create economic loss approaching two billion dollars annually; and

WHEREAS, in light of limited financial resources, the Commonwealth must ensure that the most effective means for improving highway safety are used; and

WHEREAS, new methods of solving problems must be investigated and effective evaluation processes implemented to enable us to gain from past experience.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Robert P. Casey, Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and other laws, do hereby continue the **Governor's Traffic Safety Council (GTSC)**.

1. Composition.

a. The following agency heads or designated deputies will serve in person as members of the GTSC:

(1) Secretary of Transportation, Chairman.

(2) Director of Governor's Policy Office.

(3) Secretary of Health.

(4) Commissioner of Pennsylvania State Police.

(5) Secretary of Education.

b. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House are each requested to designate one member of their respective bodies to serve as members of the GTSC.

c. The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court is requested to designate a representative to serve as a member of the GTSC.

2. Mission. To provide advice, leadership, and recommendations to the Governor and citizens of the Commonwealth on highway safety issues in order to continue to improve safe highway mobility throughout the Commonwealth.

3. Administration.

a. The GTSC shall meet at least twice each year. Additional meetings shall be at the discretion of the Chairman.

b. The Deputy Secretary for Highway Administration is designated as the Governor's Highway Safety representative to carry out the responsibilities and functions of the Highway *Safety Act* of 1986, P.L. 89-564, as amended.

c. The Director, Bureau of Highway Safety and Traffic Engineering, will serve as Secretary to the GTSC and Coordinator of Highway Safety Programs.

4. Rescission. Executive Order 1980-8, Highway Safety, is rescinded.
