

# Information Technology Policy Cable/Satellite Television (CATV) Services

#### 1. Purpose

The purpose of this Information Technology Policy (ITP) is to establish enterprisewide standards and policy for the use of the Commonwealth's cable and satellite television (CATV) infrastructure located in the Commonwealth's Capitol Campus Complex and other Commonwealth owned buildings where it exists.

# 2. Scope

This ITP applies to all offices, departments, boards, commissions, and councils under the Governor's jurisdiction (hereinafter referred to as "agencies"). Agencies not under the Governor's jurisdiction are strongly encouraged to follow this ITP.

# 3. Background

Commonwealth Media Services (CMS) manages the CATV infrastructure in the Commonwealth's Capitol Campus Complex and several Commonwealth owned buildings. CMS provides consulting and engineering design services that enable agencies to use the Commonwealth's CATV services. Agencies can use the services to view or broadcast content such as live or taped video or multimedia.

# 4. Policy

Agencies seeking CATV services shall review the information provided at <a href="https://pacast.com/catv/">https://pacast.com/catv/</a> and contact CMS at <a href="gssvccmsrequest@pa.gov">gssvccmsrequest@pa.gov</a> to determine whether CATV services through CMS are available for their location. If CMS CATV services are available for their location, agencies may utilize those services.

CATV wiring and installation services are provided by vendors on state contract at the expense of the agency. The agency's selected vendor shall meet with CMS staff to survey the physical location and review technical specifications before work begins.

Agencies shall contact CMS to obtain television compatibility information prior to the procurement of any televisions.

## 5. Responsibilities

#### 5.1 Agencies shall:

- Contact CMS to obtain prior approval for the installation, expansion, modification, or removal of CATV services.
- Select a wiring and installation service vendor from the approved contract and ensure the vendor coordinates with CMS staff.
- Contact CMS to obtain television compatibility information.

#### 5.2 CMS shall:

- Manage the CATV infrastructure located in the Commonwealth's Capitol Campus Complex and other Commonwealth owned buildings where it exists.
- Respond to agency requests related to CATV services, availability, and compatibility.
