
- Provided opening remarks, conducted roll call, and briefly reviewed the agenda for the Board's fifteenth meeting.

 - Data sharing outreach packets were mailed in mid-July. As of August 28th, 28 counties have signed data sharing agreements. This represents an increase of 22 counties since the mailing.
 - Northwest GIS Conference scheduled in October. Sean Crager will present relevant material.
 - Compliments were extended to PASDA in appreciation for their assistance and all that they have done with data sharing.
 - Work groups
 - Hydrography: The Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) has hired staff for hydrography. PEMA is interested in participating in this workgroup; but, currently are resource shy.
 - NG911: activities to complete gap analysis are in proceeding.
 - <u>ACTION:</u> Mr. Hutchins will share a link to the NG911 GIS template that was published August 27, 2019.
 - Service Delivery Task Force (Pages 9-10):
 - Meeting with Office of Administration Open Data team to enhance links for open GIS data sets was held. Further discussions planned.
