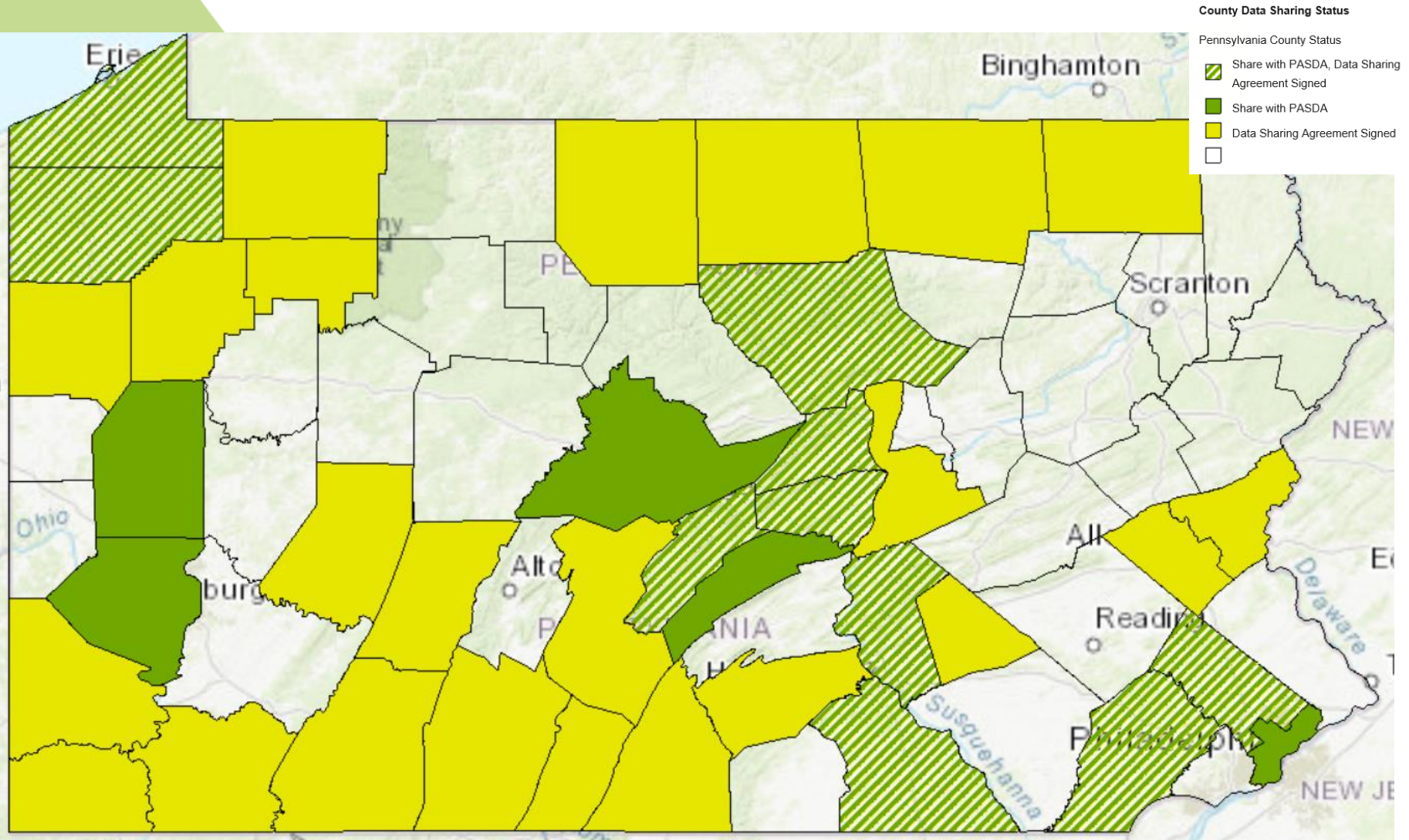
JOINT TASK FORCE UPDATE

DATA PROGRAM TASK FORCE


- Data Sharing Agreement
 - 33 counties have signed; 49% complete
 - Continue drive for 100% by year end
 - Intend to send follow-up letter to the counties that are still contemplating the opportunity
 - ❑ Include FAQs and map of participating counties
- Spoke at the NW GIS Conference
 - Some counties were in attendance

- PASDA and Turnpike Commission have successfully established a portal to Portal Collaboration Workflow
- Motivate users to create and develop better metadata
- Continued communication with PA Open Data Portal
 - Receive many requests related to parcel data and questions about GIS data
 - ❑ Link to and send these users to the PA Base Map
 - ❑ 16 counties are currently sharing parcel data
- Ensure that data is being archived for historical purposes
- Display high-level statistics on data that is shared

GOVERNANCE TASK FORCE

Legislative Review Subcommittee (LRS)

➤ House Bill 1106

- Last Meeting Refresher: the LRS and Davey Resource Group (DRG) found common ground on HB1106 proposed language reservations to jointly bring to PSLs for discussion
- Recently: LRS, DRG, and PSLs held a joint meeting to work through language reservations on 10/23/2019
 - ❑ Some minor alterations were discussed
 - ❑ Successful agreement to alterations
 - ❑ **Agreed upon language**
- Currently: Draft Bill currently with Rep Emerick who has a co-sponsor memo out.
 - ❑ PSLs hopes to have the Bill in committee early 2020
- Future: Once a legislative draft is developed, LRS will review and issue special report and request Board vote on official position

GOVERNANCE TASK FORCE

Geodetic Work Group (GDC)

- Educational component for working group members complete – deep dive into what the 2022 datum change entails and the pros/cons of different options RE: PA's future datum and projection scheme
- Progressing towards common ideal to create as few as zones as possible for the state while still achieving 50 ppm design criteria
- NGS would design the set of SPCS zones based on common agreement from state stakeholder groups (GeoBoard members involved)
- Preparing special report on SPCS2022 (State Plane Coordinate System 2022)
- Preparing PA Coordinate System Legislation language to propose
 - Has been discussion of including a Commonwealth-wide CORS network in the legislation. Exploration will continue.
- SW chapter of PSLS has circulated a proposal for a two-pronged solution.
 - A single zone for state-wide actions
 - Multi zone to have high accuracy
