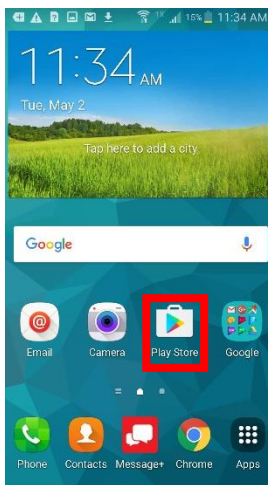


Installing Checkpoint VPN on Android

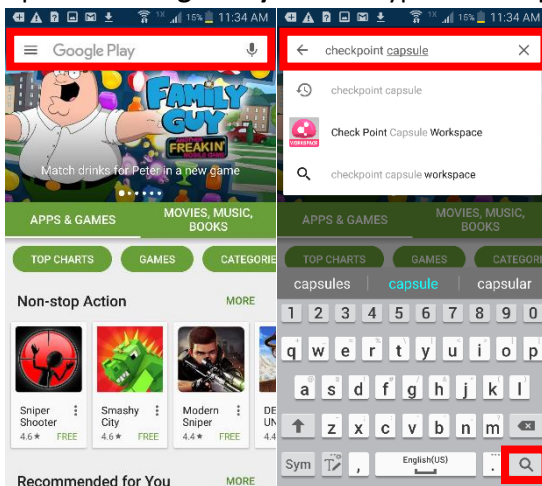
The following will give you step-by-step instructions for installing the Checkpoint VPN app on your Android device.

Installing Checkpoint App

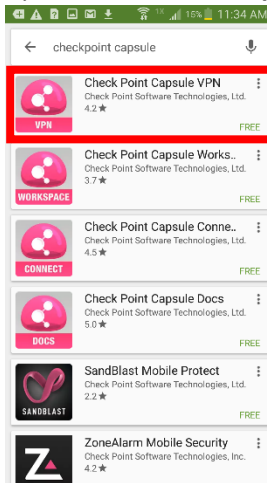
1. Click on the **Google Play Store** app on your phone.



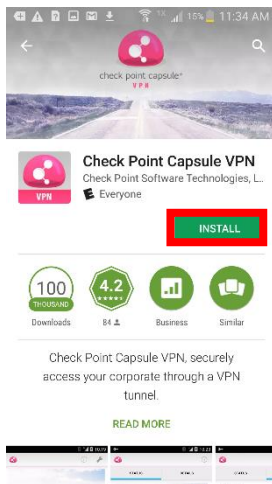
2. Tap on the **Google Play** bar and type in **Checkpoint Capsule** and tap the magnifying glass.



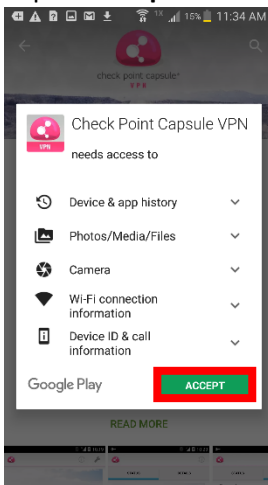
3. Tap on **Check Point Capsule VPN**.



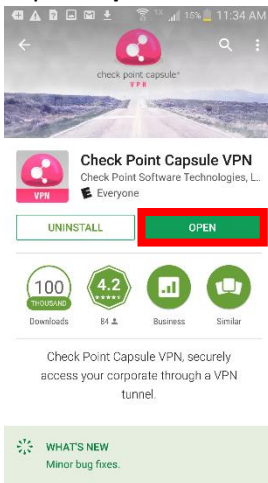

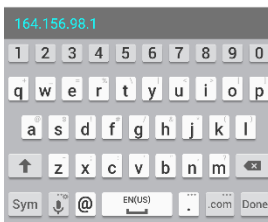
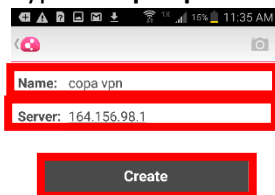
5. Tap on **Accept**.



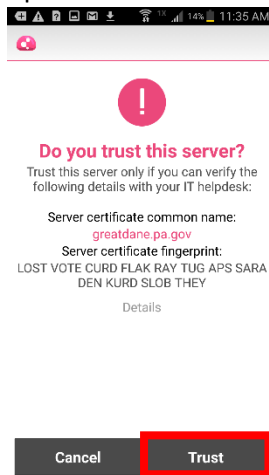
6. Tap on **Open**.



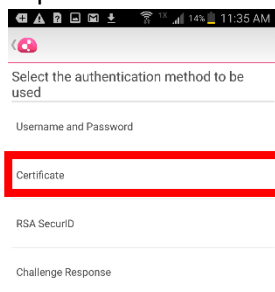
7. Type in **copa vpn** in the name field and **164.156.98.1** in the server field. Tap **Create**.



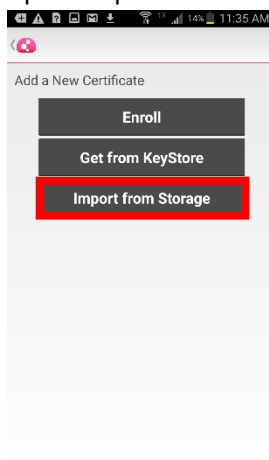
8. Tap Trust.



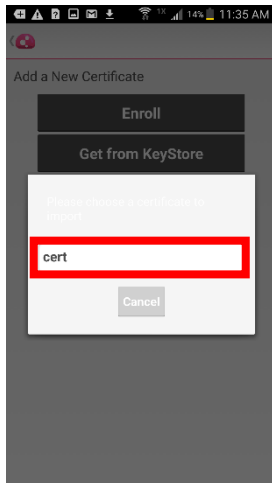
9. Tap on Certificate.



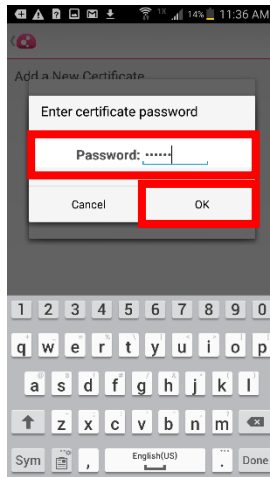
10. Tap on Import from Storage.



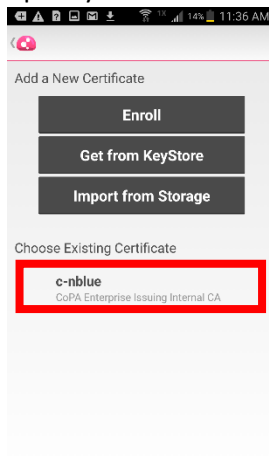
11. Tap on your certificate.



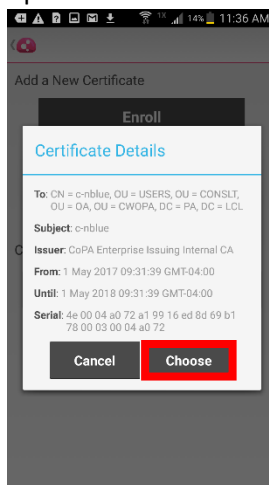
12. Type in your certificate password and tap **OK**.



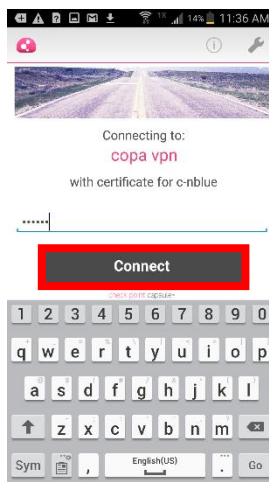
13. Tap on your certificate.



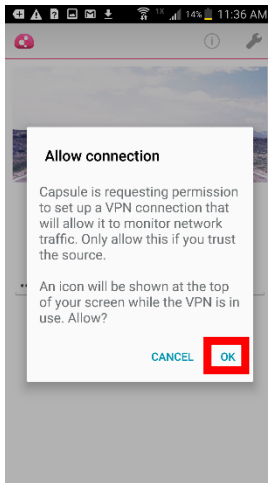
14. Tap on choose.



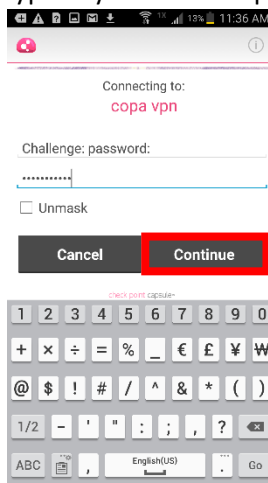
15. Type in your certificate password and tap **Connect**.



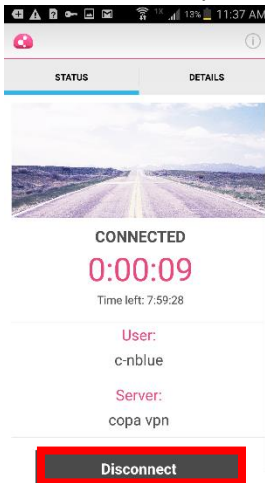
16. Tap on **OK**.
