1. Purpose

This Information Technology Policy (ITP) establishes enterprise-wide standards and policies for office productivity technologies.

2. Scope

This ITP applies to all offices, departments, boards, commissions, and councils under the Governor's jurisdiction (hereinafter referred to as "agencies"). Agencies not under the Governor's jurisdiction are strongly encouraged to follow this ITP.

3. Policy

Agencies shall standardize on the current <u>Office Productivity Software</u> identified in *STD-SFT007A*, *Office Productivity Standards*. The current standards have been tested for compatibility with enterprise applications.

The creation of content using <u>Video Sharing Services</u> that includes Commonwealth content and information and is intended for distribution shall be reviewed and authorized by the appropriate agency personnel and shall comply with <u>Management Directive 205.34 Amended, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Information Technology Acceptable Use Policy</u>, Enclosure 1, sections 11 and 12 and <u>MD 220.1, Commonwealth Media Services</u> prior to distribution.

Agencies shall adhere to <u>ITP-ACC001, Information Technology Digital Accessibility Policy</u> to ensure the appropriate accessibility steps are taken during the procurement process of alternate Office Productivity Software.

4. Responsibilities

4.1 Agencies shall:

- Comply with the requirements as outlined in this ITP.
- Receive an approved ITP waiver prior to deploying any Office Productivity Software that is not identified in STD-SFT007A, Office Productivity Standards (Refer to Section 8 for ITP waiver guidance).

4.2 Office of Administration, Office for Information Technology shall: Coordinate with the Agency's Continuity of Operations Program Manager to ensure that all software supporting essential functions (i.e., business or IT), including any Office Productivity Software, are properly categorized, and submitted in the Application Inventory and aligned to the enterprise online continuity planning software.
