- WHEREAS, Commonwealth employees have regularly provided voluntary financial support to charitable organizations through the annual State Employee Combined Appeal (SECA); and
- WHEREAS, voluntary financial support to charitable organizations has been facilitated through the payroll deduction system; and
- WHEREAS, the interests of the Commonwealth are to encourage charitable giving to a broad range of needs and to avoid both overburdening the payroll deduction system and disrupting the workplace of Commonwealth employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Thomas Ridge, Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and other laws, do hereby authorize the use of payroll deductions by Commonwealth employees for charitable contributions through SECA.

Consistent with this order, the Secretary of Administration is hereby delegated the authority to administer, through the Directives Management System, the structure of SECA and the responsibilities of the Commonwealth to SECA.

Executive Order 1985-1 is rescinded.
