





Create a communications plan for the GeoBoard. It should address both internal and external communications, as well as technical and non-technical audiences. Components to include:


- Messaging and graphics

3DPA Demonstration Program will foster innovative uses of PA data in 3D environments by public, private and academic stakeholders. The goal will be to build an incubator type environment for enabling 3DPA on a broader scale that shows the potential for hosting and providing access to 3D data.

Increase GIS Community awareness regarding methods of, and responsibility for long-term data access, archive, and security for data elements of PA BaseMap. Subject matter would encompass public and private access requirements, include local government data, and a minimum time frame of 50 years.

6. Data Program Task Force

Encourage integration of data development and maintenance as the fundamental nature of PA BaseMap 2030

- b) Host separate meetings wherein all working groups explore and document data elements and points in which workflows could or should converge to another specific base layer


